

Since September 2023, schoolbooks, workbooks, and copybooks for children in primary schools have been provided through Government funding under the Primary Free Book Scheme. For the 2023/2024 school year, the funding was €96 per pupil. This has been reduced to €80 per pupil for the 2025/2026 school year.

Your child will receive a combination of new books, workbooks, and books from the school's existing supply. These materials will be distributed when school resumes on **28th August 2025**.

We kindly ask that all books are treated with care and kept in good condition so they can be reused by other children in future years. Please ensure your child takes responsibility for keeping their schoolbooks safe and well-maintained.
