

Since September 2023, schoolbooks, workbooks, and copybooks for children in primary schools have been provided through Government funding under the Primary Free Book Scheme. For the 2023/2024 school year, the funding was €96 per pupil. This has been reduced to €80 per pupil for the 2025/2026 school year.

Your child will receive a combination of new books, workbooks, and books from the school's existing supply. These materials will be distributed when school resumes on **28th August 2025**.

We kindly ask that all books are treated with care and kept in good condition so they can be reused by other children in future years.

Stationery Requirements

Below is a list of the required stationery for your child. These items are not covered by the Primary Free Book Scheme and will need to be provided by parents, as the school is unable to supply them.
